COVID-SAFETY THIS HALF TERM

Obviously, in light of the government's most recent announcement, we will be doing everything possible to offer continuity to your children by staying open and providing a safe and welcoming environment for your children.

Please continue to support us by adhering to social distancing on and near the school site, and encouraging your children to be extra vigilant at home and school about washing hands and affording others plenty of space. We must continue to request that adults and children displaying any possible Covid symptoms are kept away from school, tested promptly and that results are shared at the earliest opportunity with the school.

Please remember that if any member of your household is being tested, the whole household must isolate for 14 days or until a negative result is received to avoid any possibility of passing on the virus. If your child is isolating, work will be provided via ClassDojo so as to avoid your child falling behind with his or her classwork- we are aiming to offer 2-3 hours of work per day, and work should be completed UNLESS your child is unwell and unable to complete any schoolwork. The new features within ClassDojo enable staff to record a video presentation for your child to watch before starting their Maths, English or topic task and offer interactive links to other videos and sites each day.

Whilst we do not have sufficient ICT equipment for all children to borrow devices simultaneously, and we have only been able to procure a limited number of resources through the government laptop scheme, if any isolating children do not have access to a suitable tablet, iPad or PC for completing their school work in isolation, a school device can be loaned out, which will be sanitised thoroughly before loan, and on return to school before re-use. Please contact the office if your child is isolating and would like to make use of a school device. We will let you know more about remote learning if your child does need to access their remote learning portfolios of work in the coming weeks.





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KEEPING WARM

As it is clear that the coronavirus is spread through the air, especially in indoor spaces, advice to schools is to keep rooms in all areas as well ventilated as possible. We have, to this point already been doing this, but as the weather becomes increasingly colder we are aware that it would be safer and more practical if children were able to wear more clothes to school.

In the first instance we would like to ensure that all children have their school uniform top layer of jumper, fleece, cardigan or Year 6 hoody available in school at all times. If your child is particularly susceptible to cold weather, than a base layer of thermals, vest, or t-shirt might also be suitable.

Whilst the heating will be on to warm the building before the day starts, the need for constant ventilation of classrooms means that the effectiveness of the heating system throughout the day is compromised.

If the temperatures drops further coats are often too bulky to move around in comfortably in the classroom, so body warmers or gilets might be a helpful further layer. As ever, we ask that all items of clothing are clearly named.
