ABSENCE NOTIFICATION

I hope that your children will be able to attend regularly in order to benefit from the wonderful teaching in this school. If your child needs to be absent for any reason, please telephone the school on the morning of absence to confirm the reason. A follow-up note should be sent in when your child returns to school to provide a written record of your child's absence- this is kept with our registers. Please avoid booking holidays, dental appointments, haircuts or non-emergency appointments of any nature during school hours.

SCHOOL UNIFORM & LOST PROPERTY

It is lovely to see all your children back in school ready for the new school year. Our school uniform is very smart and I would like to encourage all the children to wear it proudly from today... I include overleaf the current list of regulation uniform- please do not allow your children to persuade you that they can/ should wear other items or colours! Trainers/ hoodies are not suitable for school, and children need to wear school shoes to and from school (they can bring trainers for PE) and a burgundy sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. We have a small number of second hand items available to purchase from the office if you do not have any burgundy items for your child to wear, or new items can be ordered from the office.

Please also ensure all items of clothing/kit are clearly named with your child's name in permanent marker pen or sew-in/ attached labels so that they can be returned to your child if they are misplaced and found by someone else. Staff in school during the holidays found a large number of unnamed items which had been left on pegs and lying around in school. We will return any items which are labelled to their rightful owners.

Please do not send in any items which are precious or valuable to your child such as jewellery, as these are not suitable for school. Please also avoid fashion accessories and make-up.

PLAYGROUND USE

The weather remains incredibly variable, but if recent sunny spells continue, please ensure your child has a named burgundy-coloured sun hat in school to wear at break and lunchtimes. Please apply sunscreen before your child comes to school.

RULES FOR RESPONSIBLE INTERNET USE

The school has installed computers and has tablets available for Internet access to help the children's learning. Please read the rules with your child; they are designed to keep

everyone safe. The full school Acceptable Use Policy is available to read via our website policies page. Please then return the attached permission form.

Children's responsible use of ICT agreement:-

- I will use only my own login and password.
- I will not access other people's files.
- I will use the computers and iPads only for schoolwork and homework.
- I will not bring memory sticks or CD-ROMs into school without permission.
- I will ask permission from a member of staff before using the computers and internet.
- I will only e-mail people I know in real life, or those my teacher has approved.
- The messages I send will be polite and sensible.
- I will not send images of myself or others, give my home address or phone number, or arrange to meet someone, unless my parent, carer or teacher has given permission.
- I will not copy or use information that does not belong to me into my school work without referring to its author.
- To help protect other pupils and myself, I will tell a teacher if I see anything I am unhappy with or I receive a message I do not like.
- I will not send virus attachments or open any attachments which seem suspicious.
- I understand that the school can check my computer files and the Internet sites I visit.
