We are pleased to once again be supporting Pound Lane Free Church Isleham (PLFC) in their endeavour to collect as many shoebox gifts for needy children as possible in the run-up to Christmas.

Your children will have brought home a leaflet about the project this week, and are invited to bring in a packed shoe box for a child which you have prepared at home, or contribute to a class box.

If you would like to contribute to a class shoebox, please approach the class teacher, who will let you know which items are still needed for the class box. Please see the Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas child website for more details. We will be collecting shoeboxes up until the 16th November. PLFC is an official Drop-Off point for shoeboxes, and is open to receive boxes from the 1st - 18th November. For many years PLFC has operated as a Satellite processing centre for OCC. This means that all boxes provided from within the CB6, CB7, and CB8 postcode areas are brought to PLFC for processing.

Thank you to everyone who feels they can contribute towards this wonderful scheme for children in need at Christmas- time in any way.

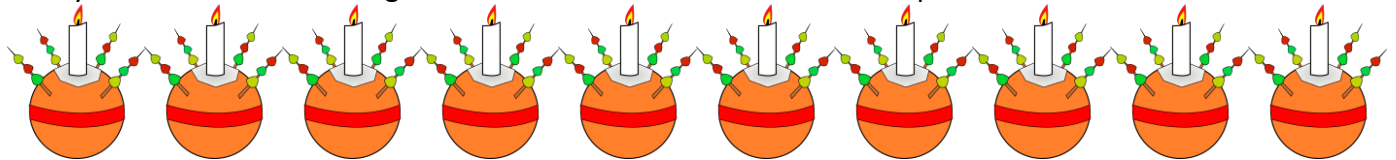

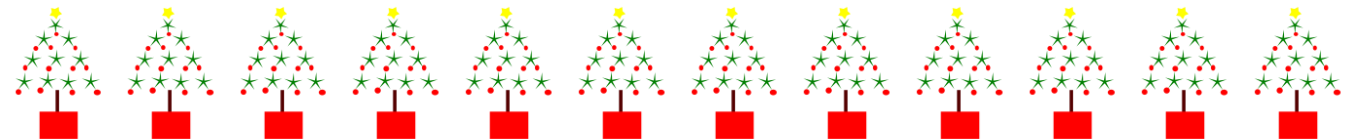
