O2 YOUNG VOICES CONCERT- CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL WHO TOOK PART!

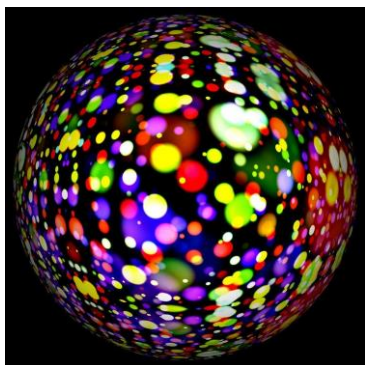
