What we are learning this term: Victorian Life

English

Over the term we will be reading and writing in a range of text types. To start the learning we will explore biographies and then move to Victorian poetry. The narrative unit of the term is the book 'Street Child' which is set in the Victorian era. The final learning will be based on alternative traditional tales.

History / Geography

The history theme is obviously about Victorian Life. The geography learning will include map understanding including how to use a key, finding locations using grid references, as well as recognising differences in location photographs.

Music and French

In Music, the class will learn a range of songs in preparation for Young Voices UK. In French, They will be asking and answering questions, Sporting activities and clothing, opinions, learning and using irregular verb 'avoir', conjunctions and negative sentences. These sessions will be led by Mrs Barber.

Science

The science unit is 'The Properties of Materials' where the children will learn how to name, describe and make changes to them. There will be a range of experiments to demonstrate fair testing and comparative skills.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be using and expanding our knowledge of place value and focusing on the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be using and developing written methods and problem solving. This year the children are expected to use 7 digit numbers.

Art / Design Technology

Within Art the class will consider the work of a range of artists including: Sargent, Adams and Basquiat. They will use a range of skills to create backgrounds and portraits. In Design lessons they will create a Victorian style sampler.

ICT and PE

In ICT lessons the class will be developing an interactive game. They will design characters and backgrounds, and create a working prototype, which they develop further based on feedback they receive. PE will include swimming games and also an indoor gymnastic session.

RE and PSHCE

RE this term focuses on Incarnation, with the question of; ' Was Jesus the Messiah?'

In PSHCE, we will be looking at Beginning and Belonging , working together, personal safety and anti-bullying.
