Please note that children who would like to be ICT Champions this term <u>must write a letter to Mr Walker</u> <u>explaining why they would like to be considered</u>. Only a small group of pupils can be selected to this role each term.

Year 6 Sports Crew have already been selected and will automatically take part in the Year 6 Sports Crew meet-ups on Friday lunchtime.
