IMPORTANT-PLAYGROUND LINING UP

It has become increasingly difficult for the children to line up in their class lines at the start of each school day in recent weeks, due to the large number of adults standing with their children in the lines, or standing in the lining-up zone after the bell has been rung...

When the bell goes in the morning at 8.55am, please say your farewells to your child promptly <u>away from the lining up zone</u>, and encourage him/her to walk to the line independently as he/she does during the school day.

If you wish to watch the lines walking in, please wait near the green fence or tree.

The growing number of adults in the lines causes the children to be unsure where their line starts and stops; and is causing some usually very settled children to cling to the adults dropping them off unncessarily, mostly because they have seen others doing this.

If your child is upset and will not walk to the line independently, please take him/her directly to the gate so that he/she can be escorted straight into school. This is very rare, and I feel sure that if all adults start to leave their children to line up independently, there will be less confusion for everyone and a calmer start to the day.
