# THE SUMMER TERM AHEAD AT ISLEHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

Welcome back after the Easter holidays. Many many thanks to you all for your support of our PTA nonuniform day and cake sale on the last day of the Spring Term 2018.



With your help the PTA raised a totally amazing amount of £408.52.

This means that last term our fundraising events of the cake stall, Mother's Day gift stalls & disco raised in total £735.52, which is a fantastic amount. Thank you.

We are currently raising funds for some much-needed resin benches so that, weather permitting, the children can enjoy lunches & learning outside. The existing wooden furniture is many years old & is beyond repair, so with your help we would like to buy several new resin benches that will last up to five times longer than wooden benches. The resin benches cost around £700 each but we are hoping to receive a substantial discount for buying multiple items.



In addition to the £735.52 that you helped us raise last term we have also been successful in our application for the Center Parcs Local Community Fund & have been advised we will receive £250 towards the benches.

We are also one of the three chosen charities in the Co-op Isleham at the moment, if you have a membership card please support us by nominating us as your charity choice. It takes seconds to do on line & is a very easy way to give money to the school without costing you a penny.

The summer term is a busy one for PTA events & we hope you will continue to support us by participating in our car wash, Father's Day gift stall, sports day T shirts & caps, summer concert & end of term disco.
