POPPY APPEAL 2016



We are once again selling poppies via the classrooms each day this week in aid of the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal. A suggested minimum donation of 50p is required for each poppy. Children are welcome to wear their poppies in school throughout this week. There are also a range of Poppy Appeal items to buy in the office including bracelets and poppy bag reflectors- the sale prices for these items range from 50p to £1.00. Please pop into the office at the start of the day if you would like to purchase one of these items for your child. (Unfortuantely , we cannot sell these in the classrooms as this may be disruptive to curriculum time through offering too many choice items for the children!) Thank you for your support. The Poppy Appeal is the Royal British Legion's biggest fundraising campaign held every year in November, the period of Remembrance. Each year, an army of volunteers distribute our iconic paper poppies throughout the nation, collecting donations in return to help support the vital work we do for the Armed Forces community. Members of the public wear the paper poppy on their chest as a symbol of Remembrance: to remember the fallen Service men and women killed in conflict. A number of Remembrance events, such as Remembrance Sunday, are held during the Poppy Appeal to commemorate the fallen. The Remembrance service at St Andrew's Church, Isleham will take place at 10.45am on Sunday 13th November. Our Year 6 House Captains will represent the school and all members of the school community are welcome to attend.

SCHOOL COUNCIL CHILDREN IN NEED 'SPOTACULAR' DAY & CAKE SALE




