PREPARING FOR SEPTEMBER 2020





We are really looking forward to welcoming all of the Isleham Primary children back to school from Monday 7th September 2020, but due to the current safety guidelines in place, it will not be possible to have everyone back this term to visit school and carry out the usual transition events to meet next year's class teachers.

Luckily though, this year all the staff are known to the children as they will have seen them around school and/or attended a club run by them. To enable the staff to get to know the children better though, your children's current teachers are setting a transition task to be completed in advance of the summer holidays.... For <u>each child to write to their new teacher and tell them all about themselves.</u>

They are asked to please use their best handwriting and decorations to show their interests and style, and to allow the teachers to see their capabilities before they enter their new class.

In the letter they will need to write about themselves, stating their hobbies, interests, and things that they like in school and at home. They could also say what they would like to achieve in their next school year and how they think that this year has gone. Teachers also like to know which subjects they enjoy, why they enjoy them and which they think that they are really good at. They might also like to know who their best friends are, so they could include that too.

You could support your child with the suggested content and enable them to include as much detail as possible, but we would ask each child to write their letter independently after the initial input. Please allow your child to use his/her own phonic knowledge and spelling words so that the teacher has a true guide of their level.



When the letter is completed please support your child to send a clear photograph and upload it onto the ClassDojo site. After 2 weeks, the new class teacher(s) will be able to read them all and respond to each child. They will also send the class a message and some information about themselves and the things they like to do.
