












ASSEMBLIES & MUSIC THIS WEEK

BEHAVIOUR POLICY UPDATE

Thank you to those parents who contributed to our behaviour policy review just before half term prior to our whole staff and governor training day.

The staff & governor team have been busy putting together a new draft behaviour policy which focuses on recognising the overwhelmingly positive behaviour on display in our school each day, and addressing any antisocial behaviour straightaway with children if it should occur through reminders and redirection

Our policy focuses on our 3 main school golden rules to help us work and play together successfully:-

We have removed the yellow card and red card system and 'golden time' as a standard conclusion to each week; however, each class teacher will continue to praise the class and work towards some shared goals or class special times such as class videos, visits to the park, or additional team games each half term.

Parents will receive notifications if their child has been nominated for 'special mention', and also, conversely, if a serious incident has occurred or repeated behavioural disruption has needed the involvement of a member of the leadership team in a 'review, repair and restore' discussion about how further recurrence can be avoided. We hope that this new policy will be well received by children, staff and parents and avoid repeated contact from the school in areas which have been addressed and discussed successfully with children in school.
