Thank you once again to everyone who supported our fundraising for the pool, and enabled the pool to be renovated for many more years' use.

Don't forget that this week we have our **Bags2School collection on Tuesday 24th** to raise further funds for the ISPA- please bring in any bags, clothes and paired shoes you can spare for the collection. The school will receive a donation based on the weight of the items collected, which will be used to fund the oil for heating the pool.

A swim hat is also needed for all children with hair which is not cropped close to their heads. We will of course help children to put these on!


