### What we are learning this term:

## Ancient Greeks

#### **English**

This half term in English, we will be learning how to write Ancient Greek style myths, consider narrative poetry, play scripts and explanation texts. In Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) we will be learning about fronted adverbials and determiners. In guided reading we will revisit important strategies needed for comprehension of texts.

#### **Science**

This half term we will begin with a biology focus by looking at how our bodies work. We will be looking at the digestive system, the journey of our food and at our teeth and tooth decay. We will then look at classifying living things and examining their habitat.

#### **History and Geography**

In History, we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks. In Geography, children will use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate areas/countries and describe features studied. We shall also be learning about 6 figure grid references and use ordnance survey maps.

#### Music

Music in the Autumn Term will focus on singing. Each week we will be learning songs in preparation for attending Young Voices 2020 at London's O2 Arena. Please see the recent letter sent home about this exciting project.

#### **Mathematics**

In Mathematics this half term we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction strategies and written methods, as well as practising our times tables and related division facts. We will also be learning about length and perimeter.

#### **Art / Design Technology**

In DT, we will be researching kites, then designing and making our own. In Art children will create Ancient Greek scratch art amphorae, mosaics and shadow puppets. We shall also consider great artists in history.

#### **PE and Computing**

PE this term will be on a Thursday and a Friday. Thursday will be our swimming lessons, for the first half term.

In Computing, the children will plan and design a game and create an on screen prototype of a toy.

#### **RE, PSHCE and French**

In RE, Mrs Barber will be covering the unit 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' In PSHCE children will be exploring 'My Emotions' and 'Working Together'. In French with Mrs Barber this half term the children will be learning vocabulary for animals, parts of the body, They will be looking at French poetry, stories and how to ask and answer questions in French.
