What we are learning this term:

The Romans

English

The focus for the first half of the term will be instructions for Roman catapults. We will then be looking at narrative writing using 'Escape from Pompeii' as a stimulus and writing information texts about volcanoes. After half term we will be reading 'Beowulf' and creating Saxon riddles.

History / Geography

We will be exploring the Roman World and their conquest of Britain. This will involve looking at coins, pictures, maps, roads and place names. We will also be finding out about volcanoes and how Roman Pompeii was destroyed.

Music and French

In Music we will concentrate on performing and analysing short descriptive compositions that combine sounds, movements and words. In French, the focus will be on greetings and French culture. These sessions will be led by Mrs Barber.

Science

In Science will be looking at Magnets and Forces. We will be investigating friction and different surfaces. We will then explore magnets and their properties and investigating which materials are magnetic both inside and outside the classroom.

Maths

We will start place value and we will also be learning about Roman numerals followed by place value. Investigative maths will be a priority - where we have to use all our number and shape skills in context. Please help by practising mental maths skills including times tables.

Art / Design Technology

To start the term we will be creating some Roman catapults using elastic bands and a range of materials. In art we will be looking at and creating our very own mosaics to decorate our classroom.

ICT and PE

Manipulating text and graphics will be the initial focus in ICT, followed by work on using the internet and e-safety. In PE we will be playing Tag Rugby on Tuesday afternoons. Swimming will take place on Tuesday mornings. Dance will be on Tuesday once swimming has finished.

RE and PSHCE

R.E this term focuses on what Christians learn from the Creation story. Working Together is our topic in PSHCE and will focus on developing self-esteem and the ability to value their individuality by recognising their positive traits and achievements.
