

## **NATIVITY SHOWS & CHRISTMAS CONCERTS**



We have now received further advice from the local authority about audiences for this month's planned nativity performances and plays.

Due to the local picture with regard to COVID-19 cases in the community, Cambridgeshire's designation as an ERA (Enhanced Response Area) has been extended to 24<sup>th</sup> December 2021. As our school lies within the current Enhanced Response Area (ERA), like all other primary schools in this area, we have been advised that 'performances with an external audience including parents/carers do not take place and streamed or recorded options are used instead.'

I am sorry for this disappointment but obviously we wish to protect your families and the children and staff from any additional risk and disruption prior to the Christmas period. We will release the videos on the final day of term for you to enjoy at home.
