
#### **KEEPING US INFORMED**

We are becoming increasingly confused and frustrated by the large number of parents expecting us to communicate daily pick-up arrangements to staff and their children, often at the last minute.

We are therefore starting a new system from tomorrow- asking you to complete or provide information to the school for a yellow slip in the morning if your child will be picked up by someone else.

Yellow slips will be available on the gate and completed by staff when you EMAIL collection arrangements to <a href="mailto:office@islehm.cambs.sch.uk">office@islehm.cambs.sch.uk</a> before 8.30am daily.

Once complete, the slips will be sent to the class teacher during the morning so they have the information on display in their classroom ready for pick-up time.



Please ensure that unless an emergency occurs such as needing to get to A&E or your car breaking down etc, the slip should be completed on the gate or a message emailed through to the school BEFORE 8.30am.

Whilst we do understand that very occasional last minute changes can occur, we simply cannot keep up with the frequent last minute changes of plan for multiple children. Please support us by planning ahead for the end of each school day so that changes only need occur in emergencies for you or your child. THANK YOU
