COVID-19- LATEST UPDATE FOR 7.2.22

As we approach half term, we will continue to provide daily numbers of COVID-cases impacting our attendance data via school comms and ClassDojo- please continue to be alert to COVID-19 and ensure your child does not attend school if experiencing any symptoms. We are seeing a decline in numbers of cases, but some school families are still being inconvenienced and becoming ill with COVID-19. Daily lateral flow testing is still recommended for close contacts (ie school classmates, family friends and staff) who have been in contact with a new case within the past week. Thank you to all families who have continued with the daily lateral flow tests and advised the school straightaway if their child is required to isolate.

Easter holidays begin after school on Friday 1st April, and children return to school on Wednesday 20th April 2022




