### **COVID-19- LATEST UPDATE FOR 24.1.22**

Numbers of reported COVID-19 cases amongst the school's population appear thankfully to be reducing now, but obviously we are still conscious that we have reported cases in almost every class. As you will undoubtedly be aware, the government have suggested that most schools can reduce their restrictive measures now, especially in situations where there are only isolated COVID-19 cases amongst the school population. There has been confirmation however that schools experiencing an 'outbreak' like ours should maintain their 'stepped-up' protective measures until this has been contained. Your support in maintaining the good health and hygiene measures we currently have in place is requested so that children can attend school without increased risk of exposure to COVID-19.

These include the following:-

- Wearing of masks by adults in communal spaces
- Ventilation of indoor spaces throughout the school day
- 'Ringfencing' individual year groups to avoid mixing across the class groups
- Enhanced cleaning regime to include all touchpoints, communal resources etc at regular intervals each day
- Sanitizing hands at regular intervals including before and after toilet use, touching communal resources, eating etc
- Activities planned to reduce face to face contact and furniture organised accordingly
- Early reporting to school families if children are potential close contacts of anyone testing positive
- Recommendation of 7 day LFD testing for potential close contacts amongst the school community
- Support of face masks in school for any pupils preferring to wear these

Thank you for your ongoing support despite this difficult situation and all you are doing to minimise disruption for your children.

We have taken the precaution of cancelling the planned PTA school disco on 11.2.22 for all children, and will run virtual parents' evenings on 22.2.22 and 3.3.22 if visits to school are still not recommended at that time. No final decision about parents' evenings has yet been made however until we understand how our local picture looks in the run-up to half term.

### LOGO LIFT OFF COMPETITION BY THE UK SPACE AGENCY


