**COVID-19- WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD IS OFF SCHOOL BUT WELL ENOUGH TO CARRY OUT SCHOOL WORK?** The guidance is changing once again this week so that a positive LFD test results will require you or your child to isolate for up to 10 days. Hopefully this will enable families to be sure much more quickly of the need to isolate. If your child should test positive for COVID-19 via a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test, from Tuesday this week, he or she will no longer be required to book a confirmatory PCR. It will therefore be beneficial for your family if you are not already taking part in LFD testing, to have some Lateral Flow tests at home in case your child should develop any symptoms of COVID-19 or have been in close contact with a positive case so that you can test at home straightaway. This helps you to protect your family and other members of the school community by isolating as soon as possible to stop the spread of COVID-19 in the community, especially if your child is asymptomatic or appears to just have an ongoing winter cold.

If your child should test positive via PCR or LFD, he or she will be required to isolate until at least day 7 after the first positive test. A negative LFD test result on day 6 AND 7, means your child can attend school on Day 7. IF YOUR CHILD IS STILL TESTING POSITIVE ON LATERAL FLOW DEVICE TESTS ON DAY 6 AND 7, HE OR SHE MUST CONTINUE TO ISOLATE UNTIL HE OR SHE TESTS NEGATIVE FOR 2 CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR UNTIL DAY 10. (This guidance may change in the near future though!)

## SCHOOL CONTACT

Please contact the school at the earliest opportunity if your child does receive a positive LFD test result, so that we can let other parents know that they need to be vigilant as their child has been in contact with a positive case.

Although your is required to stay at home, unless he or she incapacitated and bed-ridden your child is still required to carry out school learning on school days. We do not wish your child to fall behind due to any further absence as a result of COVID-19.

For children in Year 1 to Year 6, your child's work will be set via ClassDojo- he or she needs to log in AS A STUDENT – NOT using your parent code....



Your child should use their own QR code or login links so that they can see their portfolio and the latest work tasks set each day. Please email [head@isleham.cambs.sch.uk](mailto:head@isleham.cambs.sch.uk) if your child does not have their own QR code login. Up to 4 hours of work tasks are expected to be completed each day.

Please note that although day 1 of your child's absence will include more generic tasks, the teachers will set the work daily after this to include the work planned for your child in task.

Work can be submitted to the teacher for marking via the submit button within the portfolio section of your child's ClassDojo pages.

Please support us by ensuring your child logs in daily and completes the daily work tasks if isolating UNLESS they are too poorly. We are keen for the children to avoid any further disruption to their learning. iPads can be borrowed if your child does not have access to a suitable iPad or laptop to use for their learning throughout the day.

Reception class work will be sent through via email and can be uploaded to Tapestry on completion.
